

For all cancelled classes, students will be responsible for learning the material that was to be covered.

1. **Lecture** - If a scheduled **Lecture** is cancelled, the PowerPoint and MP3 files from the previous year will be made available, or if appropriate and available, a new PowerPoint file with voiceover will be posted.
2. **OMM Lab** - If a scheduled **OMM Lab** is cancelled, the Media Site Live file from the previous year will be made available, or if appropriate and available, a new PowerPoint file with voiceover will be posted.
3. **Neuroanatomy, Gross Anatomy, or Histology Labs** - If a **Neuroanatomy, Gross Anatomy, or Histology Lab** is cancelled, it will likely not be rescheduled, but students can make-up lab work on their own time as necessary or desired.
4. **Clinical Labs or Activity**

If a **Clinical Lab or Activity** is cancelled, the instructor of record will notify students of any make-up activities; the PowerPoint and MP3 files from the previous year will be made available, or if appropriate and available, a new PowerPoint file with voiceover will be posted.
5. **Small Group**
  - a. If a group facilitator does not show-up for a **Small Group** session, students are expected to conduct the session independently without the facilitator
  - b. If more than five students are absent, the facilitator has the option to continue the discussion with the small group or to join other groups that are in session **Small Group** session.
  - c. All student absences are to be reported to the Curriculum Office and the IOR.
6. **Problem Sets**
  - a. If a **Problem Set** is cancelled, the Curriculum Office will work with the assigned faculty to reschedule the activity, as the schedule permits.
  - b. If a student misses a problem set due to illness he/she should work one-on-one with the appropriate faculty member to make-up the missed work.
7. **CCE's** – will be individually rescheduled by the CCE Office as necessary and possible. All student absences are to be reported to the Curriculum Office and the IOR.
