

Donation Guidelines

SHARE Kenya-Ohio

We gladly accept donated supplies for the SHARE Kenya-Ohio program throughout the year. Because Ohio University is a tax-exempt institution, any donations made to the university on behalf of SHARE Kenya-Ohio may enable the donor to claim them as a tax-deductible donation as long as the following guidelines are followed.

Cash/check donations

All checks should be made payable to the Ohio University Foundation. A notation should be made (in the memo section or attached letter) that it is for SHARE Kenya-Ohio.

Supply donations

If an individual or business wants to donate supplies, please have them provide the following:

- Name and address of the person or business making the donation
- An itemized list of the donated items including the approximate value of each item

Please provide an itemized list of supplies even if you do not wish to receive the tax- exempt credit. The lists will help us maintain an accurate inventory of supplies and, more importantly, allow us to provide a comprehensive list of items to customs officials. We also would like to **thank the donors** for their generosity and support of the SHARE Kenya-Ohio program.
